

LGHS Uniform & Dress Code

It goes without saying that the primary guideline for our students' dress in school and out, is Halacha.

In addition to Halacha, we have a strictly enforced dress code for appropriate in-school wear. Please make sure that your daughter has enough of each of the items of the uniform.

Shirts

Available to order on Landsend.com with our school code **900168402**. The blouse must have a logo and cover the elbows and collarbone at all times.

Sweaters

There are three school sweater options with logos available to choose from on Landsend.com with our school code **900168402**.

There is a thinner v-neck, and a thicker button-down or zip up sweater. In the winter students sometimes layer up with two sweaters. We recommend purchasing more than one sweater option. A school uniform shirt, with the buttons closed, must always be worn under the sweater.

Only the three school sweaters with logos are allowed to be worn in school. This is the only form of outerwear that may be worn in school. No hoodies or other jackets are acceptable.

Uniform pleated skirt

The navy pleated skirt is available to order from locally from Tilboshet (773-982-9003) or other uniform stores and must cover the knees at all times, including while sitting.

Legwear and Footwear

Black or navy tights only

Shoes must have full backs; cros or slippers may not be worn to school.

General appearance

Makeup and nail polish are not permitted in school.

Only refined earrings are allowed (ex. none below chin length, no large hoops, no loud earrings, one per ear)

Hair should be neat and respectable and well kept.

Rosh Chodesh and Birthdays

Rosh Chodesh is celebrated as a women's Yom Tov. On the first day of Rosh Chodesh and one's Birthday, students may wear a dressy top (No denim or sweatshirts). They are required to wear the uniform skirt.
